

Defiance County Junior Fair Livestock Sale

Animals offered for sale are the projects of 4-H or FFA members of Defiance County. Animals are sold with the understanding that no drugs have been used unless sufficient withdrawal is allowed after treatment. All Junior Fair exhibitors at the Fair have completed Quality Assurance training and Livestock Skill-a-thons.

BIDDING STRUCTURE

The bidding structure will be based on a Premium Bid. This means the buyer will pay the actual amount he/she bids.

For Example:

Sale #	Tag #	Exhibitor	Parent	Weight	Base Bid (Support Price)	Bid Price or Premium
1	900	Chrissy Clover	Mr. and Mrs. Clover	200 lbs	\$106.00 (.53 x 200 lbs)	\$200.00

If the buyer does not want the animal, he/she should state **PACKER** and the buyer pays \$200.00

If the buyer wants the animal for a hog roast and chooses to send it to a local butcher he/she would state **KEEPER** and state where the animal will be processed. The buyer would then pay the support bid of \$106.00 **PLUS** the premium bid of \$200.00 for a total of \$306.00

BUYER RESPONSIBILITIES

1. For those who keep an animal, **KEEPER**, it is the buyer's responsibility to notify the butcher and coordinate their animal's transportation. Animals **MAY NOT** be released until Friday at 9:00 PM.
2. Destination is final upon completion of sale. Animals become the property of the buyer at sale.
3. All buyers are asked to pick up a sale receipt or invoice at completion of sale. Payment is encouraged the day of sale. We ask that all buyers pay within 30 days of sale. Exhibitor sale checks are held until all buyers have paid.

MULTIPLE BUYERS

We encourage several buyers to pool their resources and purchase an animal. Multiple buyers will receive individual invoices. All buyers must have a sale number. Please remember that exhibitors are not paid until payment is received from the buyer. Please complete the multiple buyer card to indicate how the bid is to be split.

PHOTOS

Buyers of Grand Champion and Reserve Champion animals are asked to please come to the photo area under the tent immediately following their bid for a picture with the exhibitor and animal.
